1 Affordable Medications

2 Agency for Health Care Administration: Changes to Medicaid

The AHCA made the following announcement related to COVID-19 changes. A letter granting an 1135 waiver submitted by Florida can be found [here](#).

Prior Authorization Suspended: Applicable to medically necessary services: hospital, physician, APRN, Physician Assistant, home health, durable medical equipment and supplies

Limits on Services Waived: Applies to limits on early prescription refills for maintenance medications (except controlled substances). Patients diagnosed with COVID-19 will also have no limits on duration, frequency, and scope of services

Co-payments: All co-payment requirements are waived for all services
Provider Enrollment: All medically necessary services for patients diagnosed with COVID-19 will be reimbursed, regardless of where provider is located

4 Access to Health Care/Health Plans

[Aetna](#) - (until 6/4/20) Zero co-pay telemedicine visits – for any reason.

[AvMed](#) - (3/17/20) Free diagnostic COVID testing, free home delivery of prescriptions; and early refill capability of maintenance medications.

[Bright Health](#)- (3/17/20) - Early medication refills, expanded coverage for COVID health care, more transportation coverage.

[Capital Health Plan](#) - (3/17/20) - Earlier medication refills. Telehealth not covered for all plans.

[Cigna](#) - (3/17/20) - Telehealth coverage flexibility for customers with immunosuppression, chronic conditions or who are experiencing transportation challenges to be treated virtually by in-network physicians; free home delivery of up to 90-day supplies for Rx maintenance medications.

[Compass Rose Benefits](#) - (3/17/20) - Free telemedicine services through Doctor on Demand and through an in-network primary care provider if offered.

[Florida Blue](#) - (3/9/20) - Early medication refills, flexibility with formulary.

[Health First Health Plans](#) - 3/10/20 - will temporarily reduce out-of-network cost-sharing to in-network-cost sharing amounts, where applicable, and will permit Medicare Parts A, B and supplemental Part C benefits to be provided at facilities that are not contracted with Health First.
